## Welcome to Eidsvoll 1814 – the Cradle of Norwegian Democracy

As the place where the Norwegian Constitution was drawn up and signed in 1814, Eidsvollsbygningen (Eidsvoll House) is one of Norway's most important national symbols. The Constituent Assembly consisted of 112 delegates, who gathered here from April 10<sup>th</sup> until May 20<sup>th</sup> 1814. The Constitution is dated May 17<sup>th</sup> 1814, which is celebrated as Norway's National Day. Today, the museum encompasses the Eidsvoll House itself, along with subordinated buildings such as the Democracy Centre in Wergeland House, the Museum Shop, and Kafé Standpunkt with al fresco dining. All these buildings are surrounded by a lush green park. You may also enjoy a short stroll along some of the trails and view adjacent outdoor exhibitions in beautiful scenery by the river.
