## Walk on water

Fetsund Lenser is a former sorting and bundling site for log driving. The 2,5 km long site is now a National Heritage Site beautifully situated by the river Glomma and the offers the unique and exiting experience of «walking on water» on the connecting rafts.

A guided tour offers an interesting insight into the historical importance of this industry and the everyday life of the plant workers.

Enjoy a taste of the popular local specialty “pike-burger” and visit the charming museum shop ENDELJ'

The Wetland Centre offers child friendly exhibitions and activities showing the biological diversity in the wetlands of the nearby Nordre Øyeren nature reserve.
