Welcome to Galleri Würth

Galleri Würth Norway opened in 2003 and is one of 15 exhibition spaces in Europe presenting the German Würth Collection. Prof. Dr. h. c. mult. Reinhold Würth started collecting in the early 1960s, and today the collection holds approximately 17,000 works of art. It consists of paintings, graphic art and sculptures from modernism to contemporary art, as well as a significant number of late medieval art works. Exhibitions rotate regularly. Galleri Würth offers free guided tours every Sunday at 13:00. It is possible to book private events and guided tours, held by educated art historians. At Galleri Würth we organize art and business events, as well as put together various educational art programs.
